### Senior High (Grades 9-12) Youth Gathering Registration Info

COST: \$115 per person (payment due with your registration) (\$125 after February 16)

- Includes programming and a Gathering t-shirt, also includes Friday snacks, Saturday breakfast & lunch
- REGISTRATION: Opens January 25th @ 5:00 pm --- Closes February 16th @ 4:30 pm
- GROUPS: Groups must register with one adult (21 yrs. or older for liability reasons) for every 7 youth.
  - o If HS students wish to attend, but their church is not attending and/or they do not have an adult to attend with them– please, contact Interim Coordinator, Pastor Christa Forsythe, contact info above.
- ROOMS: The hotel block of rooms at the Best Western in New Ulm are held through February 16th. You will receive an email confirmation from Gathering Registrar, Shaun Luker, once you are registered. After receiving that confirmation email with the hotel registration form, please, email Erin Lafferty at the Best Western in New Ulm and use our hotel form. Form will be emailed to you as confirmation of registration.

# LYO BOARD ELECTIONS

Your new SW MN Synod Lutheran Youth Organization (LYO) Board will be elected at the Senior High Youth Gathering. This is an amazing opportunity for youth to serve their church, synod and community while growing in faith and leadership skills. Please encourage youth from your congregation to run for this board. It is a rewarding leadership and faith building experience.

The LYO Board is responsible for planning and leading the Jr. and Sr. High Youth Gatherings and representing the voice of youth on a synod level. The LYO board is a leadership team that requires maturity, leadership skills, responsibility, openness, creativity, a significant investment of time, faith and trust in God and sharing the Good News of God's love with others, and a desire to grow in and share one's faith. Board members receive training to grow in their skills and accomplish their assigned tasks.

Youth from your congregations in grades 9-11 are eligible to run for one-year LYO board terms—thirteen seats are up for election. The elected youth will choose their own officers during LYO training in June. After the gathering, the current 2023-24 LYO board will appoint 2 additional board members to increase diversity on the board.

Serving on the LYO board involves a time commitment of attending LYO training in the summer, 2 weekend meetings/retreats, and planning/leading the Jr. and Sr. High Gathering.

Forms received by the online deadline (March 6<sup>th</sup> at Noon) will be distributed to gathering participants to aid in the election process. (Students may still fill out an application in person, due by March 8<sup>th</sup> at 10 PM) All youth who run for the LYO board will need to fill out an online application (electronic form only), which can be found on the Youth Gathering webpage – <a href="https://swmnelca.org/event/sryg/">https://swmnelca.org/event/sryg/</a>.

### The 2024-2025 LYO board must commit to attending all of the following events:

- Training: June 9-11, 2024 (Gustavus Adolphus College, St Peter, MN)
- Planning: September 14, 2024 (Synod Office in Redwood Falls)
- JH Gathering: November 21-24, 2024 (Willmar Convention Center)
- Training: January 17-18, 2025 (Green Lake Lutheran Bible Camp)
- SH Gathering: either March 6-9, 2025 or April 3-6, 2025 (location TBD)

If you know you will be unable to attend more than one meeting or will not make your participation in the LYO board a priority, please consider letting someone who is able to make the commitment and be present for more meetings have the chance to serve on the LYO Board. Your commitment to LYO starts with a training to build foundational skills in leadership and create relationships of trust within the LYO community. Participation in training is essential and expected. If you miss more than one meeting, other than for illness, an emergency, a death in the family, or unavoidable school conflict like a school play – your term on the board may be ended due to scheduling conflicts.

Past experience in leading a small group is helpful but not required. We trust your judgment to ask youth who would be gifted listeners and leaders.

Small groups are made up of approximately 8-10 youth from similar grades. Each small group leader should attend a required training on Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup> beginning at 5:45 PM. More information will be emailed about this training time as we get closer to the gathering.
