Senior High (Grades 9-12) Youth Gathering Registration Info:

- <u>REGISTRATION</u>: **Opens February 5th @ 6:00pm and Closes March 4 @ 6:00pm.

 - You will receive an email confirmation from the synod once you're registered. This email will include a hotel form. Please fill out the hotel form and email it to Carmen Bengston at Redwood Lodge, contact info below. The hotel block of rooms at Redwood Lodge will be held through March 4th.

- <u>COST</u>: \$65 per person (online payment due with your registration). Cost will increase to \$80 after February 28th.
 - Reg fee includes programming, a gathering t-shirt, snacks, and Saturday lunch. You must pay a registration fee to attend. Students & parents/adults are not allowed to attend otherwise.
 - Online payments only. Gathering payments are made online when registering. Electronic checks are accepted. ***Registrations are non-refundable and will not be confirmed until payment is made.*
- <u>GROUPS</u>: **Groups must register with one adult (21 years or older for liability reasons) for every 7 youth. If students wish to attend, but their church is not attending and/or they do not have an adult to attend with them, please contact LYO Coordinator, Pastor Seyward; <u>seyward.ask@swmnelca.org</u> or 678-427-7612
- <u>ROOMING</u>:
 - Again, we require a ratio of 1 adult leader (21 years or older) to 7 youth. Each congregation may decide how to assign rooms. Depending on how many people you put in each room, extra pillows, sleeping bags, or an air mattress may be needed.
 - Persons from different churches may be housed together. Please contact Pastor Seyward with questions.
 - We do our best to create a safe haven for all people. We do <u>not</u> allow adults to sleep in the same bed as youth. We also ask adults to use the rule of 3– Never have one adult and one youth in the sleeping room alone. When an adult is in the sleeping room, make sure there are two youth present. We do this for the protection of youth, adults and our congregations. If you have questions or want to request non-binary housing, please contact Pastor Seyward.
- <u>PACKING LIST</u>: sleeping bag, pillows, and extra bedding if needed, towel/wash cloth, toiletries, pajamas, change of clothes, weather-appropriate clothing, supper or money for supper as you travel to the Gathering Friday night, prescription medication if you take it in its original container/packaging. Optional: spending money & chargers for phones/electronics. **Other than taking photos, please refrain from using phones & other tech during worship.
- <u>OFFERING & SERVICE PROJECT</u>: This year, offering will go to Safe Avenues in Willmar, MN. We'll also be assembling bathroom kits for survivors. - <u>HEALTH PROTOCOLS</u>: If you are sick, please do not attend the gathering. We will have a Registered Therapy Team on site for the event, which includes a Therapy Dog who is a Malamute/German-Shepherd/Husky.

SERVICE PROJECT

This year's offering and service project at the Senior High Youth Gathering will benefit Safe Avenues of Willmar, MN. They provide advocacy, parenting time services, and emergency shelter for survivors of domestic and sexual violence. Please visit their <u>website</u> or learn more about their mission, vision, and the people they serve below.

Mission: To provide advocacy, parenting time services and emergency shelter for survivors of domestic and sexual violence.

Vision: Eliminate the oppression that exists in the community by providing education, victim advocacy, parenting time services, systems intervention and agency collaboration.

Who Safe Avenues Serves: Safe Avenues provides domestic and sexual violence victim advocacy to 7 primary counties in Southwestern Minnesota. We provide emergency shelter for a larger 18 county area covering the lower Southwestern corner of Minnesota. In addition, we provide safe parenting time services for families in need.

For this year's service project, we will be collecting supplies to assemble bathroom kits provided by Safe Avenues to persons in their programs. Their biggest needs are for our congregations to bring underwear of all sizes (modern-styled) for kids, men, and women. These are for families in their shelter and survivors of sexual violence.

Supplies needed for the kits include:

- Travel size body wash
- Travel size shampoo
- Travel size conditioner
- Disposable razors
- Toothbrushes

• Travel size toothpaste

- Deodorant
- Underwear for men
- Underwear for women (no thongs)
- Underwear for children
- Large plastic totes

Thank you in advance for working with your congregation to collect supplies to support survivors of domestic and sexual violence in our synod.

LYO BOARD ELECTIONS

Your new SW MN Synod Lutheran Youth Organization (LYO) Board will be elected at the Senior High Youth Gathering. This is an amazing opportunity for youth to serve their church, synod and community while growing in faith and leadership skills. Please encourage youth from your congregation to run for this board. It is a rewarding leadership and faith building experience.

The LYO Board is responsible for planning and leading the Jr. and Sr. High Youth Gatherings and representing the voice of youth on a synod level. The LYO board is a leadership team that requires maturity, leadership skills, responsibility, openness, creativity, a significant investment of time, faith and trust in God and sharing the Good News of God's love with others, and a desire to grow in and share one's faith. Board members receive training to grow in their skills and accomplish their assigned tasks.

Youth from your congregations in grades 9-11 are eligible to run for one-year LYO board terms—thirteen seats are up for election. The elected youth will choose their own officers during LYO training in June. After the gathering, the current 2024-25 LYO board will appoint 2 additional board members to increase diversity on the board.

Serving on the LYO board involves a time commitment of attending LYO training in the summer, 2 weekend meetings/retreats, and planning/leading the Jr. and Sr. High Gathering.

All youth who run for the LYO board will need to fill out an online application, which can be found on the Youth Gathering webpage – <u>https://swmnelca.org/event/sryg2025/</u>. Forms received by the online deadline (due April 4th at Noon) will be distributed to gathering participants to aid in the election process. Students may still fill out an application in person at the gathering (due April 4th at 10:00 PM).

If you know you'll be unable to attend more than one meeting or are unable to make your participation on the LYO Board a priority, please consider letting someone else have the chance to serve on the LYO Board. Your commitment to LYO starts with training to build foundational skills in leadership and create relationships of trust within the LYO community. Participation in training is essential and expected. If you miss more than one meeting, other than for illness, an emergency, a death in the family, or unavoidable school conflict like a school play – your term on the board may be ended due to scheduling conflicts.

All candidates must fill out an online application (electronic form only, found on the SW MN Synod Youth Gathering webpage) before voting takes place on April 5, 2025. SMALL GROUP LEADERS

Small groups are a SUPER-MEGA-IMPORTANT part of the Senior High Youth Gathering and are awesome for creating friendships between youth from all over the Synod. It makes the whole gathering much more unforgettable for the youth.

We are asking you as an adult leader to find 10-12th grade youth that you believe would absolutely ROCK at leading a small group. We're looking for 25 youth to step into this leadership role. Past experience in leading a small group is helpful but not required. We trust your judgment to ask youth who would be gifted listeners and leaders. Small groups are made up of approximately 8-10 youth from similar grades.

Each small group leader should attend a required training at the beginning of the Senior High Youth Gathering on Friday, April 4th at 6:30 PM. More information will be emailed about this training time as we get closer to the gathering.
